CHILDREN

As participants of the program children should be encouraged to provide feedback and advice regarding the program. Without the support of the children involved the program cannot succeed. Children not participating in the program should be encouraged to support the positive benefits of the program for those who do participate.

Role of Children

- Follow the rules of Walk on Wednesday
- Listen to and respect the Adults who are walking with you.
- Arrive on time at the designated meeting point.
- Provide a positive image of the program particularly for those younger children who will benefit from the safety aspects of the program.



Walk on Wednesday Rules

- Parents are responsible for their children until the Walking Group arrives at their designated “meeting” point.
- It is the responsibility of children/parents to arrive at the designated stop prior to drop off times.
- Except in emergencies or for reasons of safety the Walkers must keep to its agreed timetable and route.
- The Warrnambool City Council officer must be notified if there are hazards on the walking route.
- Parent walkers are not responsible for other childrens’ behavior and any breach of the child agreement will be referred to the school and appropriate action taken.
